

Heatcraft Gas 2 Go® “Race 2 Win” Promotion

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Entry is only open to valid trade customers of Heatcraft Australia who are operating in Australia. To participate in the promotion individuals must be Australian residents and aged 18 years or over. Prizes will be awarded to the company/business named on the qualifying transaction invoice or where no company/business is named to the person named on the invoice. For the sake of clarity, if a qualifying purchase is made on behalf of a company/business, the prize will be awarded to the company/business and the internal policy of that company/business will determine who retains the prize within that company. Major Prize must be taken from 13/06/2013 to 17/06/2013. All prizes must be claimed and redeemed in line with the dates provided in these Terms and Conditions and directly to the relevant winners by the Promoter.
2. Employees and their immediate families of the Promoter, the Promoter’s competitors, printers, suppliers, providers, Heatcraft outlets/stores and agencies associated with the promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
3. Promotion commences on 11/03/2013 and closes for purchases on 25/05/2013 at 5pm AEST or when stock of Race 2 Win scratch cards runs out at a participating outlet/store, whichever is first to occur (“Promotional Period”). Claims for instant prizes in-store must be received immediately after a qualifying purchase is made, with final claims closing at 5pm AEST on 25/05/2013. Claims for ‘hot lap’ instant prizes must be received by last mail on 31/05/2013. 50,000 game cards will be distributed in this promotion. All promotional material, including information on how to enter form part of these Terms and Conditions.
4. To receive one (1) Race 2 Win scratch card, eligible entrants must purchase a Gas2Go® cylinder product from a Heatcraft Wholesale branch, authorized agent or joint venture store in Australia during the Promotional Period. Entry into the promotion is only valid for purchases of Gas2Go® cylinder products. While stocks last, one (1) Race 2 Win scratch card will be awarded for each Gas2Go® cylinder product purchased at a participating store/outlet. To find out if they have won an instant prize, entrants must scratch the relevant panel on the Race 2 Win scratch card.
5. Instant Prizes:
 - 3 x ‘hot lap’ experiences (as outlined below) - \$1,100 each;
 - 200 x Erebus Motorsport V8 caps – RRP \$30 each
 - 500 x Gas2Go® Caps – RRP \$15 each;
 - 500 x Gas2Go® Sports bags– RRP \$25 each;
 - 500 x Gas2Go® Cooler Bags– RRP \$15 each ;
 - 500 x Gas2Go® Stainless Travel Mugs– RRP \$10 each;
 - 500 x Gas2Go® Golf Umbrellas– RRP \$40 each; and
 - 500 x Heatcraft Beanies– RRP \$10 each.
6. All instant prizes other than the ‘hot lap’ experience prizes must be claimed in the store where the qualifying purchase was made, immediately after the qualifying purchase. Entrants must fully complete the relevant section of their original Race 2 Win scratch card with the requested details and then surrender their original Race 2 Go Scratch Card to the staff in the store to claim the prize shown on the scratch card. To claim a ‘hot lap’ experience prize entrants must fully complete the relevant section of their original Race 2 Win scratch card with the requested details and then mail the original scratch card in a stamped envelope to the address specified on the scratch card so that it is received by 31/05/2013. The Promoter recommends that winners use registered post; however, this is not a condition of claiming a prize and the cost to do so will be the responsibility of the winner.
7. All winners of instant prizes who complete the relevant section of their original Race 2 Win scratch card and submit the original scratch card to the Promoter (as per the instructions provided above) will be automatically entered into the Major Prize Draw. Non-winners of instant prizes can also enter the Major Prize Draw by fully completing the relevant section of their original Race 2 Win scratch card with the requested details and then placing the original scratch card in the entry box provided in store during the Promotional Period. All scratch cards must include the requested personal details and the details of the invoice/receipt related to the qualifying transaction.
8. Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one (1) Race 2 Win scratch card will be awarded per specified purchase requirement; (b) only one (1) entry into the Major Prize Draw permitted per Race 2 Win scratch card; and (c) each entry/claim must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
9. Entrants must retain their original purchase invoice(s)/receipt(s) for all entries as proof of purchase. Failure to produce the proof of purchase for all entries when requested may, in the absolute discretion of the Promoter, result in invalidation of ALL of an entrant’s entries and forfeiture of any right to a prize. Purchase invoices(s)/receipt(s) must clearly specify the products purchased, the store/outlet of purchase and that the purchase was made during the promotional period but prior to entry.
10. The ‘hot lap’ experience prizes: There will be one (1) ‘hot lap’ experience prize at Calder Raceway Vic, one (1) ‘hot lap’ experience prize at the Sydney Motorsport Park NSW and one (1) ‘hot lap’ experience prize at the Qld Raceway. Each ‘hot lap’ prize includes two (2) laps at the relevant racecourse for the winner as a passenger in a Mercedes racing car driven by a professional driver selected by the Promoter and is valued at \$1,100. Winners of each ‘hot lap’ experience prize must make their own way at their own cost to the relevant racecourse location to attend the ‘hot lap’ experience prize. Any costs incurred in taking a ‘hot lap’ prize, including but not limited to any transport, transfer and accommodation costs will be the responsibility of each winner. The dates during each ‘hot lap’ prize must be taken will depend on racecourse and driver availability. Each winner will be advised of the exact dates for their ‘hot lap’ session once these dates become available (and well in advance of the relevant session), however, each prize will take place before December 31st 2013.
11. Each winner of the ‘hot lap’ prize (“Racing Experience Prize”) acknowledges that motor racing is a dangerous activity, which may result in injury or death, and participates at his/her own risk. The Erebus Motorsport V8 will provide the Racing Experience Prize (“Prize Supplier”). The winner (a) must attend, undergo and pass any appropriate training, briefings, safety demonstrations, required medical tests and other requirements (including blood alcohol testing) of the Promoter and the Prize Supplier as determined by them in their absolute discretion; (b) must declare to the Promoter or the Prize Supplier any health-related issues that may affect his/her safe participation in the Racing Experience Prize and obtain a written clearance from their doctor in this respect; (c) must not have any heart condition or history thereof, or other medical conditions that would make it dangerous to participate in the Racing Experience Prize; (d) must not be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol; (e) must comply with all directions of the Promoter, the Prize Supplier, the nominated driver and race officials; and (f) must wear all safety and other equipment required. The Promoter and the Prize Supplier in their absolute discretion (a) will nominate a qualified driver; (b) reserve the right to refuse to allow the winner to take part in any or all aspects of the Racing Experience Prize if they reasonably believe the winner poses a safety risk or for any other reason; (c) may cancel the Racing Experience Prize if the conditions are deemed dangerous. If the Racing Experience Prize is varied for any reason beyond the control of the Promoter it may not be rescheduled and in which case, no compensation will be offered.

12. If any 'hot lap' prizes remain unclaimed as at the claims close date specified above these will be distributed to other entrant(s) via the Major Prize Draw.
13. Instant winners will be notified immediately in writing via the message featured on the scratch card. 'Hot lap' winners will be published in The Australian on 06/06/2013.
14. The Major Prize Draw will take place at 11am AEST on 04/06/2013 at Heatcraft Australia, 286 Horsley Road, Milperra NSW 2214. The winner will be notified by phone & email and mail and their details will be published in The Australian on 06/06/2013. The first valid entry drawn in the Major Prize Draw ("Winner") will win the Major Prize (as outlined below) and the opportunity to play a contingency game ("the Game") for the chance to win \$100,000. In the event that any 'hot lap' prizes remain unclaimed, such prizes will be awarded to the next valid entry/entries (as applicable) drawn in the Major Prize Draw.
15. Major Prize: Major Prize is valued at up to \$4,751.74 depending on point of departure, and consists of an opportunity for the winner and one (1) adult guest to attend the 'Triple Crown' motor race in Darwin (taking place from 14 to 16 June 2013). Major Prize includes two (2) VIP pit passes to the 'Triple Crown' motor race for 14, 15 and 16 June 2013, three (3) nights' accommodation twin share at the Holiday Inn Darwin on The Esplanade, breakfasts for three (3) days at the hotel (on a set menu) and return transfers from the hotel to the Hidden Valley Racecourse. If the Winner is from VIC, ACT, NSW, TAS, WA, SA or QLD, the Major Prize also includes two (2) economy airfares from the winner's nearest capital city to Darwin, Northern Territory and return transfers from the airport to the accommodation venue. If the Winner is from Northern Territory, then the Major Prize does not include airfares and airport/hotel transfers and the airfare/transfer components of the Major Prize are not redeemable for cash. Spending money, additional meals, insurance, transport to and from departure point, additional transfers, items of a personal nature, in-room charges and all other ancillary costs are not included. Major Prize must be taken from 13/06/2013 to 17/06/2013 to coincide with the Triple Crown motor race and is subject to booking and flight availability. All travellers must depart from and return to the same departure point and travel together. Itinerary to be determined by the Promoter in agreement with the Winner but in the event that agreement cannot be reached, the Promoter reserves the right to determine the itinerary. Frequent flyer points will not form part of the Major Prize. The travellers may be required to present their credit card at time of accommodation check in.
16. The Game will take place at the Holiday Inn Darwin on The Esplanade (88 The Esplanade Darwin NT) on 14/06/2013 at 10.30am (local time). The Winner must appoint a representative, being a person aged 18 years or over present at the Major Prize holiday, ("Participant") to participate in the Game on their behalf and notify the Promoter in writing of the appointment prior to the commencement of the Game. If the Participant does not attend the Game for any reason, a representative of the Promoter will play the Game on the Winner's behalf (also a 'Participant').
17. There will be fifty (50) envelopes on display at the start of the Game. Each envelope will contain a promotional message representing a specific prize. There will be one (1) envelope representing the \$100,000 prize, seven (7) envelopes representing a \$1,000 prize, seven (7) envelopes representing a \$1,250 prize, six (6) envelopes representing a \$1,500 prize, six (6) envelopes representing a \$1,750 prize, six (6) envelopes representing a \$2,000 prize, five (5) envelopes representing a \$2,250 prize, five (5) envelopes representing a \$2,500 prize, four (4) envelopes representing a \$2,750 prize and three (3) envelopes representing a \$3,000 prize. The Participant must choose only one (1) envelope without handling or interfering in any way with any of the other envelopes on display. If the Participant is found to have breached this condition, he/she will be disqualified and the Winner will be ineligible to win a prize. Subject to verification by the judges, the Winner will win the prize that is contained in the envelope selected by the Participant in the Game. For the sake of clarity, if the Participant selects an envelope containing any message other than the message representing the \$100,000 prize, then the Winner will only win the prize represented by the message in the selected envelope and the \$100,000 prize will not be given away. If the Winner wins the \$100,000 prize, it will take up to 21 days for the Promoter's Underwriter to validate & dispatch a cheque to the Winner. Any other cash prize won will be paid out on the spot via a cheque from Heatcraft's representative made out in the Winner's name (subject to verification). The Participant in the Game must abide by the rules set down by The Insurances Assessor attending the Game on behalf of the Underwriter at all times.

For a transfer to be valid, the winner will need to furnish evidence (to the satisfaction of the Promoter) of either of these relationships (as appropriate).
21. If the Winner drawn in the Major Prize Draw fails to claim their prize by 9am AEST on 11/06/2013 they will forfeit their prize and a further draw will be conducted in order to select a new Winner, at the same place as the Major Prize Draw, subject to any directions from the relevant regulatory authorities. In the event that any 'hot lap' prizes still remain unclaimed at this time, such prizes will be awarded to the next valid entry/entries (as applicable) drawn in this draw. Any winners will be notified in writing and their name will be published in The Australian on 12/06/2013.
22. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and participants (including identity, age and place of residence and employment) and to disqualify any individuals or company/business who submits/makes an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
23. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant or participant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant or participant.
24. Incomplete, indecipherable or illegible entries will be deemed invalid.
25. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
26. Entrants consent to the Promoter using their name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.
27. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.
28. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party

interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) if any prize event is cancelled for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (f) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (g) use/taking of a prize and/or participation in a prize.

29. It is a condition of entry that the Winner (and their companion) of the Major Prize Draw and any 'hot lap' winners may be required to sign a Liability Release in the form required by the Promoter.
30. Entry and participation in this promotion is deemed to be acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
31. Scratch cards are void if damaged, stolen, forged, mutilated or tampered with in any way. Printing and other quality control errors will not invalidate an otherwise valid claim. Unless otherwise due to fraud or ineligibility under these Terms and Conditions, all valid claims for prizes will be met notwithstanding that the advertised prize pool has been exceeded. Any 'hot lap' instant win prizes that are part of the advertised total prize pool will be awarded via the methods outlined in these Terms and Conditions.
32. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries in each draw and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn.
33. Total potential maximum prize pool value is up to \$171,551.74.
34. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected prize claims or entries.
35. Prizes must be taken as offered and cannot be varied. Prize values are GST inclusive (where applicable) and are in Australian dollars and are the recommended retail value as provided by each local supplier and are correct at time of printing. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in prize value.
36. If for any reason a winner does not take/redeem a prize (or an element of the prize) by the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize (or that element of the prize) will be forfeited.
37. If any prize (or part of any prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize (or that part of the prize) with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.
38. Each prize is subject to the standard terms and conditions of individual prize and service providers.
39. If this promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, including but not limited to technical difficulties, unauthorised intervention or fraud, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate.
40. The Promoter collects personal information in order to conduct the promotion and may, for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties, including but not limited to agents, contractors, service providers, prize suppliers and, as required, to Australian regulatory authorities. Entry is conditional on providing this information. The Promoter may, for an indefinite period, unless otherwise advised, use the information for promotional, marketing, publicity, research and profiling purposes, including sending electronic messages or telephoning the entrant. Entrants should direct any request to opt out, access, update or correct information to the Promoter. All entries become the property of the Promoter.
